

BOARD COMMITTEES

The Board of Education shall refer to Standing and Advisory Committees certain tasks for research and recommendations.

COMMITTEE STRUCTURE:

1). Standing Committee

A Standing Committee shall include two (2) Board members appointed by the Board President and approved by the Board for a period of one (1) year. The following are examples of Standing Committees: Finance, Personnel, Policy, Building and Grounds, and Curriculum. Standing Committee appointments shall be made no later than the first regular Board meeting, after election of Board officers.

2). Advisory Committee

An Advisory Committee shall be comprised of one or more Board members and/or staff and members of the community appointed by the Board President for a specific period of time to accomplish a specific task. Advisory Committee membership shall be appointed by the Board.

The Board President and District Administrator shall serve as ex-officio members of each Board committee, shall be notified of all committee meetings, and shall receive a copy of the minutes of each committee meeting.

All Board committees are advisory in nature.

Findings will be presented to the Board in the form of advice or recommendation.
