

SECURITY OF BUILDING AND GROUNDS

Buildings constitute one of the greatest investments of the school district. It is deemed in the best interest to protect the district's investment adequately.

Security means not only maintenance of a secure building from a locking standpoint, but secure from physical hazards and faulty equipment. Security also extends to safe practices in the use of electrical, plumbing, and heating equipment. Records and funds are to be kept in a safe place and under lock and key when required.

A master key file for the district keys shall be maintained. Distribution of the building keys shall be at the discretion of the administrator.
