

EMERGENCY CLOSINGS

The District Administrator and/or designee shall have authority to close the District schools in the event of hazardous weather or other emergencies that threaten the health or safety of students and personnel.

When determining whether or not to close school due to hazardous weather, the District Administrator shall confer by phone with the Bus Transportation Supervisor, other Arrowhead Schools and designated bus drivers. Upon reaching a decision to close the school(s), the District Administrator shall notify the local radio stations prior to 6:30 a.m. whenever possible.

When determining whether to dismiss students early due to hazardous weather or other emergency situations, the District Administrator shall notify the radio stations at least thirty (30) minutes prior to dismissal, whenever possible.

The District Administrator shall develop other necessary plans for the closing of the schools and early dismissal to provide for orderly procedures.
