

STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

Students riding buses are subject to Wisconsin Statutes dealing with bus transportation, Board of Education policies, rules and procedures established by the Bus Supervisor, and reasonable rules and procedures as determined by the bus drivers.

Students who do not cooperate or conduct themselves in a manner conducive to the safety of themselves or others, shall be disciplined by the school principal. Drivers shall report violations of rules to the Bus Supervisor on the Bus Conduct Report form; a copy of which shall be mailed to the principal.

Students may be suspended from riding the bus by the school principal. The bus company may refuse to transport a pupil only after a report of the circumstances is made to the school principal. Parents shall be notified in writing when riding privileges have been denied.

The Merton Community School District shall not discriminate in standards and rules of behavior regarding student bus conduct, on the basis of sex, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures (see policy 6010: A.B.C.), conduct, on the basis
