

COMMUNITY RELATIONS PARTICIPATION BY THE PUBLIC

VISITS TO THE SCHOOL

The board encourages parents and other citizens of the district to visit the schools and classrooms at any time to observe the work of students, teachers, and other employees. The board believes there is no better way for the public to learn what the school is actually doing than to visit the school.

To observe a class, parents are asked to make advance arrangements with the teacher, through the office.

In order to assure that no unauthorized persons enter the school with wrongful intent, all visitors will report to the school office when entering, sign the visitors register, and receive authorization to visit elsewhere in the building. Visitors are provided with identification badges.

Any unauthorized person on school property will be reported to the administration. The person will be asked to leave. The police may be called if the situation warrants such measures.

Students will not be permitted to bring brothers and sisters to school for the purpose of babysitting. Requests to bring out-of-town visitors to school must be submitted to the principal.

Staff members shall not bring their children to school for the purpose of babysitting during regular school hours.
