

FILLING BOARD VACANCIES

The Board of Education shall use the procedure outlined below when a vacancy on the Board occurs:

1. The Board shall meet in open session to determine the method to be used in making an appointment to fill the vacancy. The Board may select from the following list of options, or the Board may use any other method not prohibited by state statute.
 - A. Appoint the next runner up from the last election.
 - B. Accept nominations from the Board, and/or use an interview process.
 - C. Request letters of interest from the public, and/or use an interview process.
 - D. Appoint a former member of the Board.

2. When a person has been selected to fill the vacant Board seat, the clerk may not swear in the nominee until the next Board meeting after the appointment has been made.
