

BOARD - ADMINISTRATOR RELATIONSHIP

The Board is responsible for governing the district as provided for in State Statutes. These provisions include policy making, educational planning, evaluation, providing financial resources, and public relations. The Board delegates executive powers to the District Administrator for operation of the district.

The District Administrator is responsible for the implementation of Board policies, for the responsibilities as outlined in the District Administrator's position description, and for keeping the Board informed about school operations. The District Administrator shall advise the Board of any additional policies which may be required for the effective operation of the school.

Board members shall refrain from involvement in administrative matters and shall not ask the District Administrator for personal considerations. All non-action matters shall be referred to the District Administrator.
