

## **GIFTS, GRANTS AND BEQUESTS**

The Board may accept and use any gift, grant or bequest which is consistent with district goals. All gifts to the district shall be offered to the District Administrator for appropriate action.

The Board may accept a gift if it satisfies the following criteria:

1. It will have a purpose consistent with goals of the school district.
2. It will place no unacceptable restrictions on any school program.
3. It will not bring undesirable or hidden costs to the school district.
4. It will not commit the Board to a program it would be unwilling to continue when gift or grant funds are exhausted.
5. It will not be in conflict with any District policy, school code or public law.
6. It will not imply endorsement of any business or product unless specifically approved by the Board.
7. It will be offered by a donor acceptable to the Board.

The Administrator may accept a gift without Board action if:

1. It meets the criteria as listed above in items 1-7, and,
2. It is for the specific purpose of offsetting the cost of programs or special events which are part of the school curriculum, or
3. It does not exceed \$100.00 in value.

The Administrator shall advise the Board of any gift accepted without Board action at the next scheduled Board meeting.

All gifts will become school property to be used at the discretion of the school unless otherwise specified in the bequest.
