

## **MEDICAL POLICIES**

### **FIRST AID**

First aid services shall be available to the students and staff during the regular school day.

First aid services shall be provided by a combination of a public health nurse from the Waukesha County Health Department, Health Room Volunteers, and the Merton Volunteer Fire Department.

- A. Health Room Volunteers should hold current first aid and CPR training with completion cards from a nationally recognized program such as Red Cross, American Heart Association, or the National Safety Council.
- B. Professional medical personnel such as RNs, LPNs, or EMTs who are current in their CPR training and are maintaining CEUs in their field are exempt from the training required in section A.

A health room shall be maintained as part of the school office within the building.

Each fall, students and staff will complete an emergency notification card which shall be on file in the school office.

**EMERGENCY CARE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES** as suggested by the Waukesha County Public Health Department for use in Waukesha County Schools shall be the guide for emergency care procedures.

In the event of serious injury, parents or guardians shall be notified as quickly as possible.
