At the last closed session meeting, the board met and discussed possible raises for the returning administrators, support staff, and confidential staff. The proposal was to raise salaries/hourly rates by 1.81%, which represented CPI. Attached is the list of returning administrators, support staff, and confidential staff with the proposed raises and salaries/hourly rates for the 20-21 school year.

AGENDA ITEM: 2020-21 Teacher (AUTO) Compensation (Action)

The Negotiations Committee Tuesday, November 17th, met with the Teachers Union (AUTO) with a proposal that represented a 2% increase to last year's teacher compensation pool. The Committee and AUTO (Arrowhead Union Teacher's Organization) failed to come to an agreement. The Board asked that the AUTO team forward the proposal to the membership for a full vote, but that request was denied.

The Board's Proposal is:

- \$500 Base Wage increase to all staff (New and Returning) This goes on the Salary Schedule
- Supplemental Wage Increase to all returners depending on their salary schedule lane placement (Not the 6 returning staff members who have already gotten increases on their contracts)
 - o BA = \$1000
 - o BA-15 = \$750
 - o MA = \$500
 - o MA-12 = \$250

AUTO would like all new salary dollars to be distributed equally to all members based on their contracted FTE. They have indicated they will not stop the district from imposing their plan.

The reason for our proposal was the discrepancy of salary between certain groups (years of experience and education) teacher's compensation between Merton and comparable school districts.



ADMINISTRATIVE RECOMMENDATION:

Now that the Negotiations Committee and AUTO have come to impasse, the District's Negotiations Committee is recommending the board make a motion to approve the proposed teacher compensation increases as presented. Compensation increases would be applied to their individual 2020-21 teacher contracts.
