I want to personally thank you for your interest in the Merton Community School District and welcome the opportunity to discuss the great things we do for kids every day. You selected Merton as a possible choice for your child's school next year. We are excited about the opportunity to showcase our district and the mission of academic excellence, inspiring curiosity, and promoting personal growth. I want to highlight some characteristics of our schools that you may or may not be familiar with.

- This past year, we were ranked the 6th Ranked School District in the state of Wisconsin according to the state's Report Card scores. Over the past several years, we are recognized as one of the highest achieving school districts in the state according to our State Report Card and Forward Exam (state assessment) test scores.
- Focus on the Core Subject areas while infusing 21st Century teaching and learning strategies.
- Newly renovated Merton Intermediate School's "Curiosity Center" to house the district's music, art, and STEM programming. These new spaces include a new manufacturing/woods center, design/robotics lab, art room, Family Consumer Education Lab, Band room, and Choir room.
- Required and elective STEAM coursework for all students 5K-8th grade with a focus on Project Lead the Way programming, manufacturing/woods, design, computer programming, and foods.
- Focus on individualized programming and growth through standardized and district wide assessments. Our literacy and mathematics curriculums are personalized to meet kids where they are at. These programs and results are used to give us details of what your child is doing well, and areas of growth.
- Continued support of our one to one (1:1) initiative to have **every** student 2nd-8th grade with a personal technology device, and two to one (2:1) for all classrooms 4K-2nd. (Chromebooks)
- Utilization of Google Applications (Apps) by our students and staff. By using Google Apps, we continue to allow our students ways to collaborate and create together. As our staff capacity and learning grows, so will our students' knowledge of using instructional technology.
- Communication across all stakeholders
 - Weekly Electronic Communication from the Building Principals
 - o Monthly Updates from the Superintendent including:
 - Board of Education meeting agendas and summaries
 - District updates and reminders
 - o Teachers report grades, homework, and messages using Skyward
 - o Continued remodeling and creation of student engaging learning environments
- Our district has common behavior expectations across all grades 4K-8 "The Merton Way"
- Strong community partnerships with the District's Parent Teacher Organization.
