#### Notes:

\* Be sure images obtained online are open for reuse and remix: "When in doubt- go without." (Use: Compfight, Pics4learning, Morguefile.com, Advanced Google Image Search -- Always monitor student image search--.) Another image source is using clip art images from Publisher and saving them as a picture (Note: no citation needed for Microsoft Office clipart.)

\* Copyright free music sources: Soundzabound, Incompetech-- Still credit your music source.

\* Avoid posting student work to web that contains non-original images/media: "When in doubt- go without."

\* Avoid archiving and redistributing resources from year to year. (Bookmark or relocate materials online. No "file cabinet.")
